## 2013 Cub Scout Resident Camp-Registration Tips!

## 10 Easy Tips- Please Read Carefully:

- 1) A minimum of 2 adults is required. A ratio of 4 Webelos/1 Adult and 2 Cub Scouts/1 Adult is required.
- 2) It is encouraged that each Pack has a **Pack Camping Coordinator** who registers families for Camp. This helps avoid duplicate registrations. We encourage the Pack to travel and arrive together.
- 3) Both Adults and Scouts should **register via this site** using the appropriate selections below. The **primary registrant will receive a full confirmation e-mail**; each additional attendee will receive a confirmation e-mail with just their information.
- 4) Gather all the information you need prior to starting online registration. **Once you have submitted a registration, you cannot go back into the system and make changes.** However, you can start a new financial transaction and register more Scouts and Adults.
- 5) Approved payment methods are **Visa, MasterCard, Automatic Check** (routing and account number), or **PayPal**.
- 6) It pays to register early! The early bird fee is \$125/Scout if paid by May 17, 2013. After that date, registration is \$135/Scout. Registration will close at Noon on June 28, 2013. Walk-in Registrations will be allowed, but supplies are limited.
- 7) Every youth and adult in camp must bring a copy of their **BSA Annual Health & Medical Record** (parts **A &B**) to camp on the first day. Scouts or Adults without health forms will not be allowed to stay at Camp. Do not submit a copy of your health form to the Council Service Center; instead bring it with you on your first day.
- 8) When selecting **Scout Rank**, please select the rank the Scout is going into. For example, a Scout starting 2nd grade in the Fall would be a Wolf Scout.
- 9) Did your unit achieve the **Friends of Scouting Incentive**? If so, be sure to select the correct registration type. If you don't know, contact your District Executive before you sign up for camp (please note- the FOS incentive DUE date is April 15th).
- 10) If your unit has a Scout that received a **Campership** (Camp Scholarship) for Day Camp. Please contact the Council Service Center, one of the Customer Service Representatives will process that Scout's registration over the phone/in person. Be prepared to pay the ramaining balance due with Visa, MasterCard, ACH, or PayPal (or if in person, cash is acceptable). The Customer Service Representative will e-mail you a confirmation letter that you can keep in your records.
