Chef Ben's Country Kitchen

For the third installment of Chef Ben's Kitchen the Chef has prepared a tasty **Scout Chili** (no Scouts were harmed in the making of Ben's Chilli).

Ingredients:

- 2 -10lbs. can Chili Beans
- 2-10lbs. can Kidney Beans
- 3- 10lbs. can Diced Tomatoes
- 2-10lbs. can Tomato Sauce 25lbs. Ground Beef or Venison
- 8 Bell Peppers

4 large Onions
3lbs. Brown Sugar
16oz. minced Garlic (1 cup)
4oz. Black Pepper (1/2 cup)
6T Beef Base
8oz. Chili Powder (1 cup)
* Hot Peppers

4qt. Water

Instructions:

- -Brown meat with all the seasonings.
- -Dump all the ingredients into large pots and simmer for hours.
- -Recommendation is to

make one pot with no hot peppers.

Note that where it says ounces I consider a handful an ounce

* Depending on how hot you want it
