The Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (OLS) course is an intensive overnight course with instruction and practice in the outdoor skills important in Scouting. You should attend if:

- You are a Scoutmaster, Asst. Scoutmaster or Webelos Leader preparing for cross over
- You work with Boy Scouts or Venturers in the outdoors
- You are planning to take part in Scout camping activities

OLS is the outdoor training session required to be fully trained as Troop Assistant or a Scoutmaster. (The other required course is BS Leader Specifics.)
