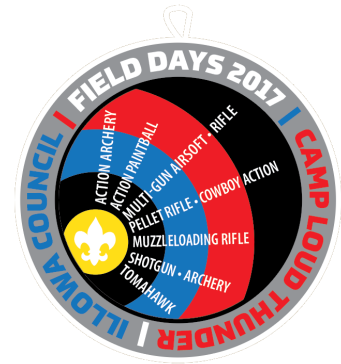


The Illowa Council Shooting Sports Committee presents . . .

FIELD DAY 2017



Who: Boy Scouts 12 and older & Venturers

When: April 22, 2017

Where: Loud Thunder Scout Reservation

Time: Check-In is at 7:00 AM in the Dining Hall. Event begins at 7:45 AM with a mandatory safety briefing and finishes with the award ceremony beginning at 5:30 PM.

Cost: \$30 (Includes Program, Eye & Ear Protection, Lunch, Patch, and Prizes for Top Scorers)

Boy Scouts (ages 12 and older) and Venturers are invited to attend the Illowa Council Shooting Sports Committee's Fourth Annual "Field Day". Participants will start their day (7:45 AM SHARP) with a very important safety briefing. If Scouts don't attend this mandatory safety briefing, they will not be permitted to participate in Field Day. During the day, Scouts will be assigned to a team where they will rotate around to 10 different action areas:

Action Archery, Action Paintball, Archery, BSA Multi-gun Airsoft, Cowboy Action (new this year), Muzzleloading Rifle, Rifle, Shotgun, Pellet Rifle, and Tomahawks

- Each action area will have specific instructions along with individual and/or team competition. At the end of the day prizes will be awarded for the Top Shot in each area, as well as for the Top Scoring Team.
- We recommend participants have a working knowledge of shooting sports as the day's schedule will not allow time for individual instruction.
- Participants must be 14 years of age to shoot Cowboy Action. Participants ages 12 and 13 will report to the catapult action area during the time their team is scheduled for Cowboy Action.

Important Information:

- Scouts must pre-register online. There are no 'John Doe' spots. Registration will close on Monday, April 10 at 5:00 PM. There will be no walk-ins permitted on the day of the event.
- Maximum of 120 participants for this event.
- A brown bag lunch will be provided. Please provide your own food if you have special dietary needs.
- NO PERSONAL FIREARMS, AMMUNITION, BOWS, or TOMAHAWKS.
- Any of our Range Safety Officers or NRA Instructors reserves the right to immediately remove a Scout from a Range if his behavior is deemed unacceptable. The parent will be contacted immediately to pick up the Scout and no refunds will be issued. Safety is our #1 priority.
