Our Plans

Loud Thunder Scout Reservation is our Eastern Iowa/Western Illinois premiere "outdoor classroom" and annually serves over 10,000 youth and adults of the Illowa Council BSA.

We are modernizing Camp Loud Thunder to meet the needs and the changing face of Scouting. Now that our facility is serving our growing female population and good family-oriented programs, the property is in need of upgrades.

**A goal of \$1,250,000 was set.
To date, \$750,000 has been raised.**

Estimated costs associated with projects listed below:

\$500,000

Bath/Shower House

Improve creature comforts, sanitation and meet privacy guidelines of Youth-Protection standards.

Shooting Sports Complex

Construct four (4) new shooting ranges to accommodate growing demand and new programs (handgun, rifle, trap and skeet).

Covered Teaching Pavilions

Increase outdoor "classroom" space to expand education opportunities to focus on Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM).

Water Treatment Building

Construct new building to house water treatment equipment above ground for better maintenance and quality drinking water.

Building Maintenance

Upgrade/remodel the existing three winter cabins and the Freytag Lodge to provide additional year-round camping amenities at Loud Thunder. These 60+ year old buildings have served our Scouts well, but are in need of continued renovations and upgrades.
