Inali Outdoor University 2017 Merit Badge Pre-Requisites

If a merit badge is not listed, it has no pre-requisites for Outdoor University.

*Everyone must dress for the weather. You will be outside for most or all of the when in classes.

Archery	<u>Bring \$10 for an Arrow Kit at check-in</u> Print and Complete Merit Badge Workbook found on meritbadge.org
Astronomy	#5B, #6B, must have the Astronomy book, and bring a pair of binoculars if able
Canoeing	For the safety of all, scouts must have previously earned the Swimming Merit Badge
First Aid	#2d must bring, must be complete, see list in scout handbook
Fishing	Rod and gear, but if you do not own any the rods will be available to use. This is lakeside fishing, so heavy saltwater gear is not needed or allowed. A sturdy freshwater rod and reel will suffice. Bait will be provided. Small pocket knife for cutting bait and a needle-nose pliers may be handy! Recommended tackle should include #8 hooks, 1/4 oz. round or oval lead sinkers or split shots, medium bobbers, and at least 10 lb test line. Tackle is not required to participate. (This is the only Merit Badge open to Girl Scouts ages 11 and up.)
Fly Fishing	Rod and gear, but if you do not own any the equipment will be available to use.
Orienteering	Have a compass, pen, and note pad
Pioneering	#2a, b, and c
Railroading	#8a, do #2 or #3
Rifle	<u>Bring \$10 for shooting materials</u> Print and Complete Merit Badge Workbook found on meritbadge.org
Scouting Heritage	#2a & b, #4, and #5
Shotgun	<u>Bring \$10 for shooting materials</u> Print and Complete Merit Badge Workbook found on meritbadge.org. Successfully complete a state hunter education course, or obtain a copy of the hunting laws for your state
Wilderness Survival	9 X 9 tarp, fireman's and totin' Chips, personal backpack with 10 essential campout gear, and personal first aid kit
