Requirements

All Applicants for ETPi Foundation Scholarship Must:

- Have been granted the Eagle Scout rank or have verified that their application for Eagle Scout rank has been received at the BSA National Office Applicants may verify this by having their local council contact the Epsilon Tau Pi Foundation at <u>scholarship@etp-foundation.org</u> or photocopy their certificate.
- Submit applications that are postmarked by August 15th. Use sufficient postage. Applicant may also send an electronic copy (word document and scans of necessary material) Submissions of electronic copies must be received by August 15th to be considered.
- 3. Be an incoming first year student entering:

The University of Dayton Western Carolina University, West Virginia University Appalachian State University, Georgia Southern University Augustana College Robert Morris University

in the year in which the ETPi Foundation Scholarship application is submitted.

- 4. Provide a transcript of high school grades covering at least six semesters (The transcript does not have to be "Official").
- Have taken the SAT and/or the ACT. Submitted scores must be a copy of an official test sheet, or on the high school transcript in Requirement 4, and must be submitted with the application.
- Have and continually demonstrated leadership ability in Scouting, and have a strong record of participation in activities outside of Scouting.
- Provide a statement by the applicant clearly stating why he believes he deserves a Epsilon Tau Pi Foundation Scholarship (max. 500 words).
- Provide one signed recommendation letter from volunteer or professional Scout leader who knows the applicant personally. This is the only endorsement required. Please do not send endorsements from teachers, counselors, etc.
- Participate in an interview with the scholarship committee. We will contact you to schedule the interview upon receiving of your application.

Procedures

All Applicants for ETPi Foundation Scholarship Must:

- Complete the application personally.
- Enclose only the items requested in the requirements (No biographies, resumes, or supplementary lists of activities). Items should not be attached to the application.
- Answer all questions on the application ("See attached" is not an acceptable answer).
- Submit all attachments with the application form to ensure that all items are available for review at the same time (Epsilon Tau Pi will not assume responsibility for matching items that are mailed separately).

- Include on each attachment the applicant's name.
