

Is any Special Equipment Needed?

An equipment list will be sent to each participant upon registration. Scouts who participate in an active Troop outdoor program probably already have the necessary personal equipment or can borrow materials from their troop. An *official BSA uniform* is required.

Medical Forms:

Every participant will be required to have a valid BSA Class II physical completed in order to attend. Scouts will not be allowed to participate without the physical.

What Does the Conference Cost?

The conference early Bird fee is \$175.00 if paid by May 30. Regular fee is \$200.00 if received after May 30. This includes all food, equipment, and training materials.

Scouts will also receive two NYLT t-shirts, an NYLT hat and appropriate recognition for successful completion of the course. A deposit of \$75.00 per scout should accompany each registration. The balance must be paid by June 30, 2014.

Qualifications:

Boy Scouts must be at least First Class rank and 14 years old and approved to attend by his **Leader**. NYLT is open to both male and female Crew, Ship and Team members. They must be 14 years of age and approved by their advisor. Because NYLT is a six day resident camp, it is expected that the Scout will have camping, cooking and hiking skills and that they will be able to function as a contributing member in the patrol setting during the course of this event.

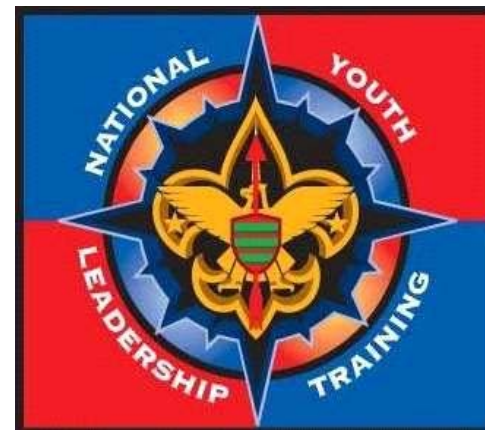

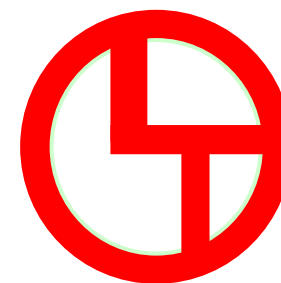

What is the Conference?
