SHOOTING EXPERIENCE

WHEN: Saturday, April 20th, 2024

WHO: Scouts BSA & Venturers. 48 participants per AM and/or PM session. (Maximum of 96 participants.)

WHERE: Loud Thunder Scout Reservation, 9906 175th St W, Illinois City, IL.

Campsites are available but *must be reserved in advance by visiting Loudthunder.org*

TIME: AM session Check-In is at 7:30 AM in the Dining Hall. The AM session begins at 8 AM SHARP with a MANDATORY safety briefing and concludes around 12 PM. PM session Check-In is at 12:00 PM in the dining hall. The PM session begins at 12:30 PM SHARP with a MANDATORY safety briefing and concludes around 4:30 PM. Participants MUST attend the safety briefing to participate. If you attended the AM Safety Briefing you do not need to attend the PM Safety Briefing.

COST: \$15 per participant for AM **or** PM session (includes program, eye & ear protection, lunch, patch). \$25 if participants shoot both AM & PM sessions. (will only receive one set eye & ear protection, one lunch and one patch). Participants must pre-register online. There are no 'John Doe' spots.

<u>Registration will close on Monday, April 15, 2024 at 5:00 PM</u>. No walk-in registration permitted on the day of the event.

HOW IT WILL WORK: The day will be broken into two sessions, the AM session will start shooting at 9 AM and finish at 12 PM and include (3 of the 4 action areas) Benchrest Rifle, Shotgun, Pellet Rifle and Tomahawks. The PM session will begin shooting at 1:30 PM and finish at 4:30 PM and include (3 of the 4 action areas) Archery, Cowboy Action, Prone Rifle, and Muzzleloading Rifle. The event is scheduled to end at 4:30 PM.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- NO PERSONAL FIREARMS, AMMUNITION, BOWS, or TOMAHAWKS.
- Bring a completed <u>COPY</u> of your health form (parts A & B). We will shred all health forms at the end of the event.
- Participants should have a working knowledge of shooting sports as the day's schedule will not allow time for individual instruction.
- Any of our Range Safety Officers or Instructors reserve the right to immediately remove a participant from a Range if their behavior is deemed unacceptable. The parent will be contacted immediately to pick up the Scout and no refunds will be issued. Safety is our #1 priority.
- COWBOY ACTION Participants 14 years of age and older with a completed Cowboy Action Hold Harmless Agreement will shoot 22 cal. rifle, 22 cal. single action revolvers, and 20 ga. coach style shotgun at steel targets. Participants 13 years of age and younger will shoot Cowboy Action style steel targets with paintball markers.
- Each action area will have specific instructions for that action area.
- A brown bag lunch will be provided. <u>Please provide your own food if you have special dietary needs</u>.
- Spectators may pre-order a brown bag lunch for \$5 each. These lunches must be pre-ordered when registering participants.
